


Liaison surveyed a random sample of 1,283 Ontario voters through Interactive Voice Recording (IVR) from March 8-9, 2024

Responses were weighted using demographic and geographic information to targets based on the 2021 Census.


The margin of error for survey results is \pm 2.74 percentage points, 19 times out of 20 for the total. Margin of error is higher for sub samples.

Results may not add up to 100 due to rounding.




Voting Intent - Provincial

Q: If a Provincial Election were held today, which party would you vote for?









Voting Intent - Provincial - Decided & Leaning Only








Q: In your opinion, is more or less housing being built in Ontario today than it was 5 years ago or is the same amount being built?






Q: Which level of government would you say is doing the most to create new housing?






Q: Which level of government would you say is doing the least to create new housing?






Q: Thinking about the construction of new housing in your own community, would you say too much housing is being built, not enough or the right amount?






Q: Thinking about the construction of new housing in Ontario, would you say too much housing is being built, not enough or the right amount?


