


Liaison surveyed a random sample of 1,280 Ontario voters through Interactive Voice Recording (IVR) from April 6-7, 2024

Responses were weighted using demographic and geographic information to targets based on the 2021 Census.


The margin of error for survey results is \pm 2.74 percentage points, 19 times out of 20 for the total. Margin of error is higher for sub samples.

Results may not add up to 100 due to rounding.




Voting Intent - Ontario

Q: If a Provincial Election were held today, which party would you vote for?









Voting Intent - Ontario - Decided & Leaning Only








Q: In your opinion, is the amount of pollution produced in Ontario increasing or decreasing compared to 5 years ago or is it the same?






Q: Which level of government would you say is doing the most to reduce pollution?






Q: Which level of government would you say is doing the least to reduce pollution?






Q: What would you say is more important: affordability and the cost of living or the protection of the environment?






Q: If it were up to you, would you abolish the carbon tax or keep it in place?


