Nova Scotia survey for the **National Ethnic Press and Media Council of Canada** 

Field Dates: October 28-29, 2024

Release Date: October 31, 2024





Liaison surveyed a random sample of 701 Nova Scotia voters through Interactive Voice Recording (IVR) from October 28-29, 2024

Responses were weighted using demographic and geographic information to targets based on the 2021 Census.

The margin of error for survey results is ± 3.7 percentage points, 19 times out of 20 for the total. Margins of error are higher for sub samples.


Results may not add up to 100 due to rounding.




### **Voting Intent - Nova Scotia**


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
