Liaison surveyed a random sample of 1,000 Torontonians through Interactive Voice Recording (IVR) from July 2-6, 2025.

Responses were weighted using demographic and geographic information to targets based on the 2021 Census.

The margin of error for survey results is \pm 3.09 percentage points, 19 times out of 20 for the total.

Results may not add up to 100 due to rounding.
