Liaison surveyed a random sample of 1,000 Canadians through Interactive Voice Recording (IVR) from August 25-27, 2025

Responses were weighted using demographic and geographic information to targets based on the 2021 Census.

The margin of error for survey results is ± 3.09 percentage points, 19 times out of 20 for the total. Margin of error is higher for sub samples.

Results may not add up to 100 due to rounding.

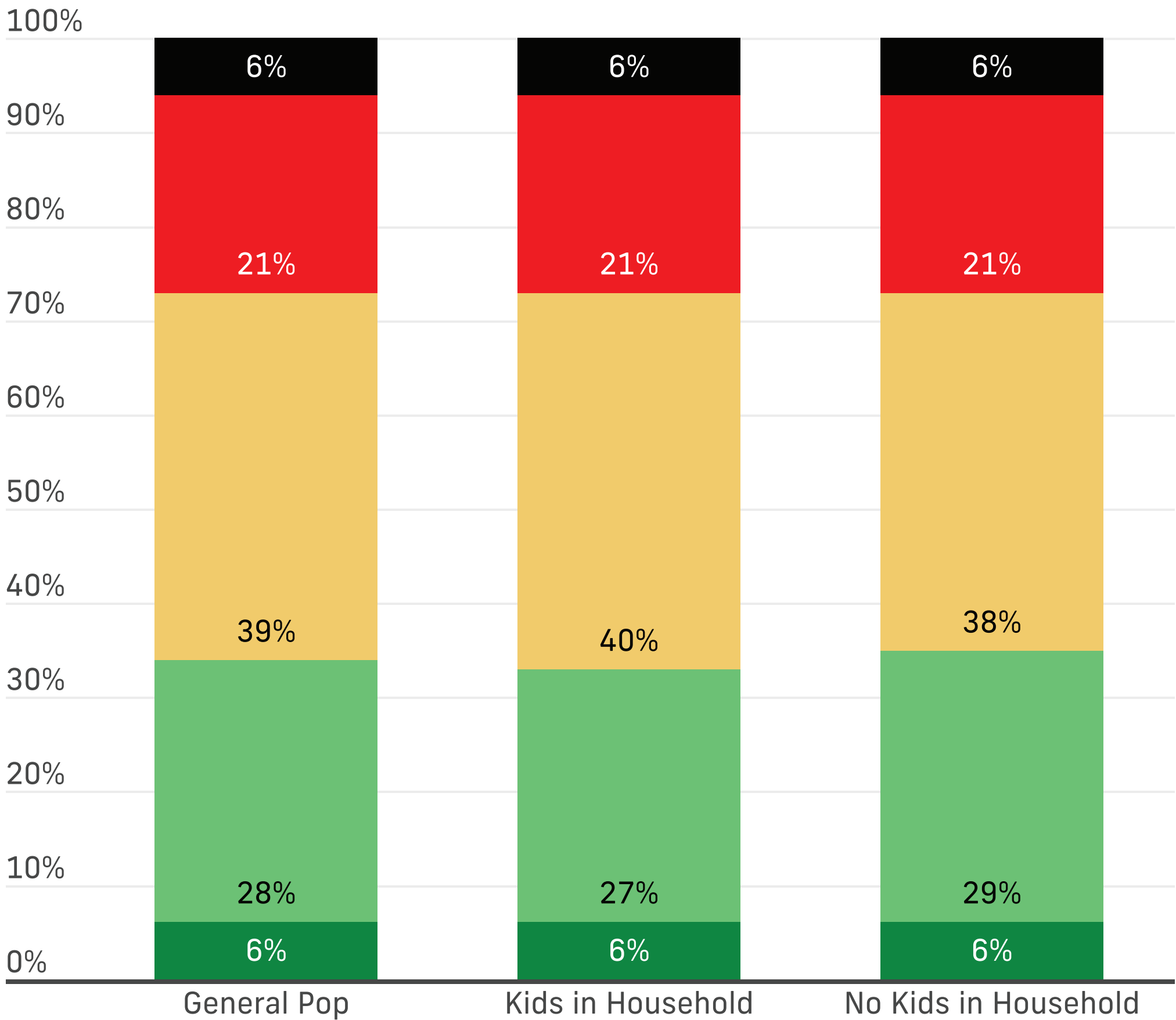

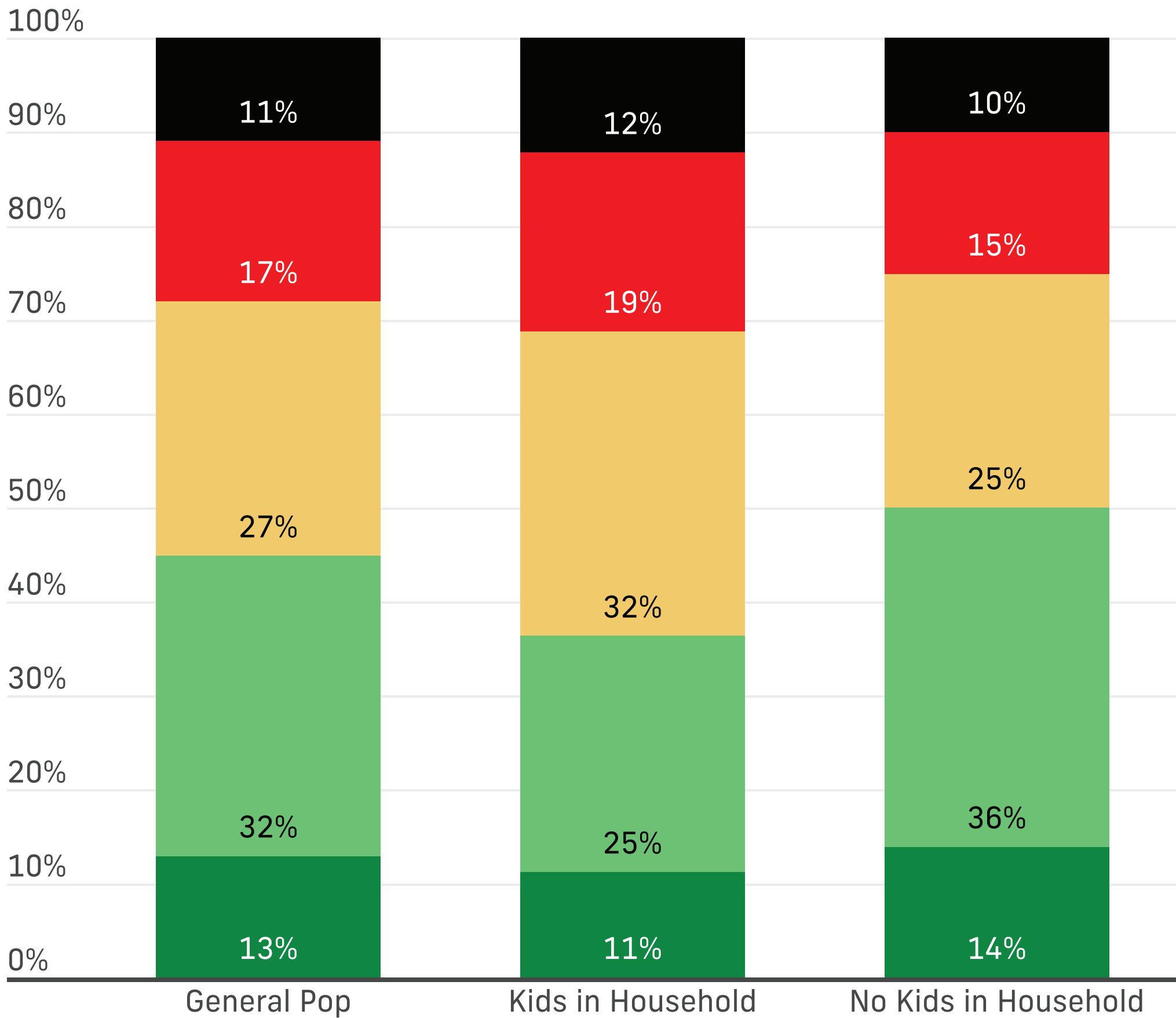

Perception of Local Schools



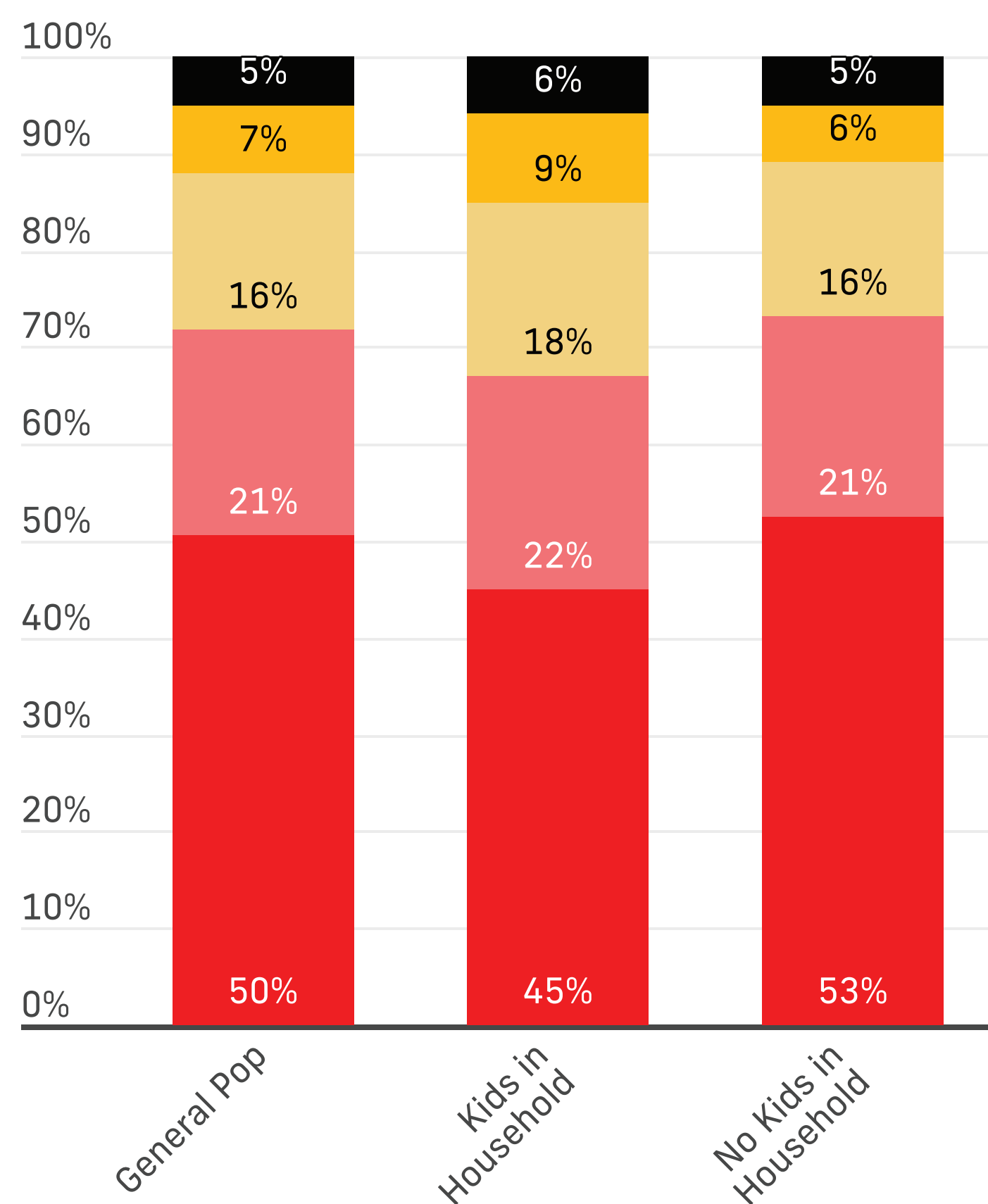

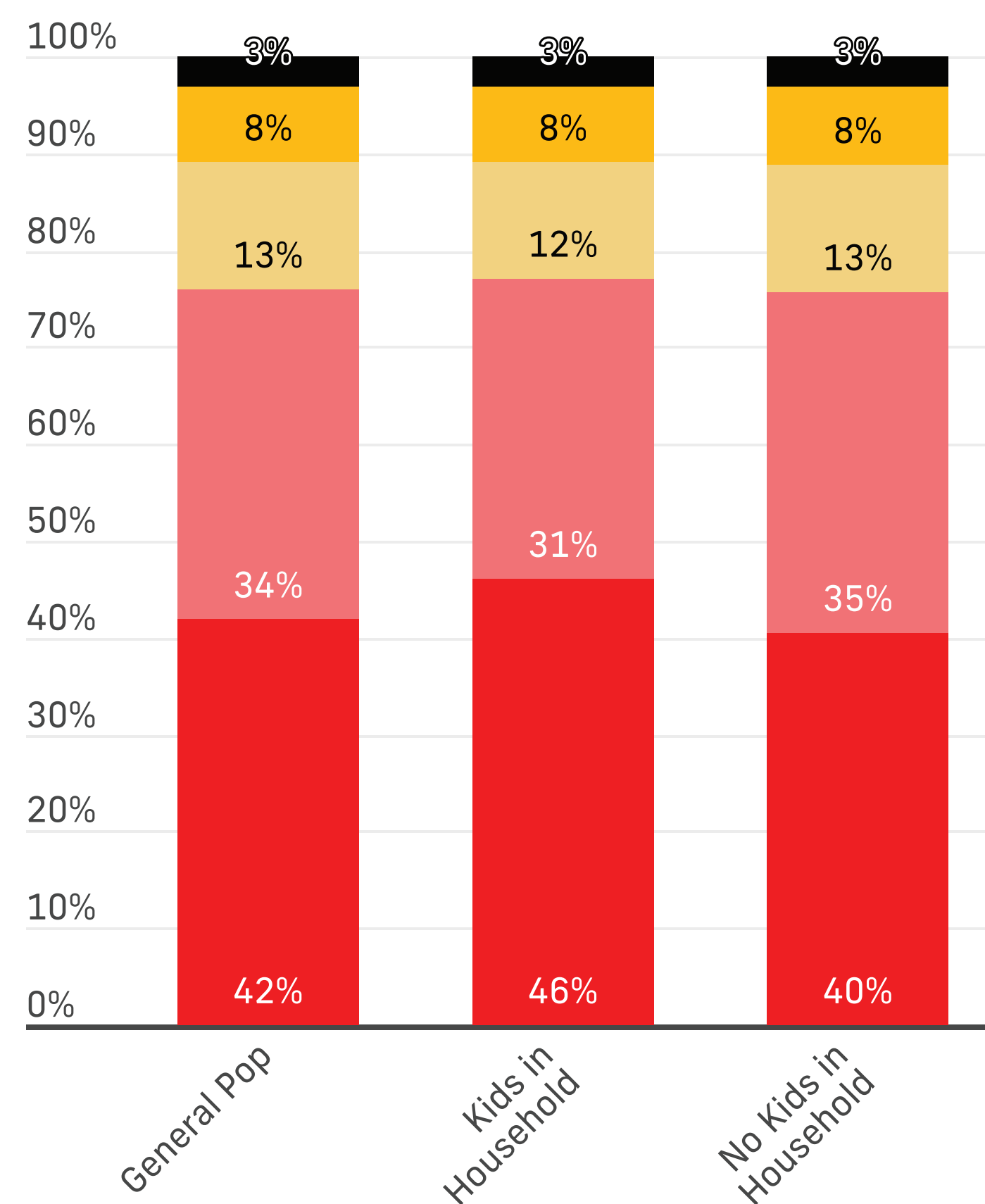

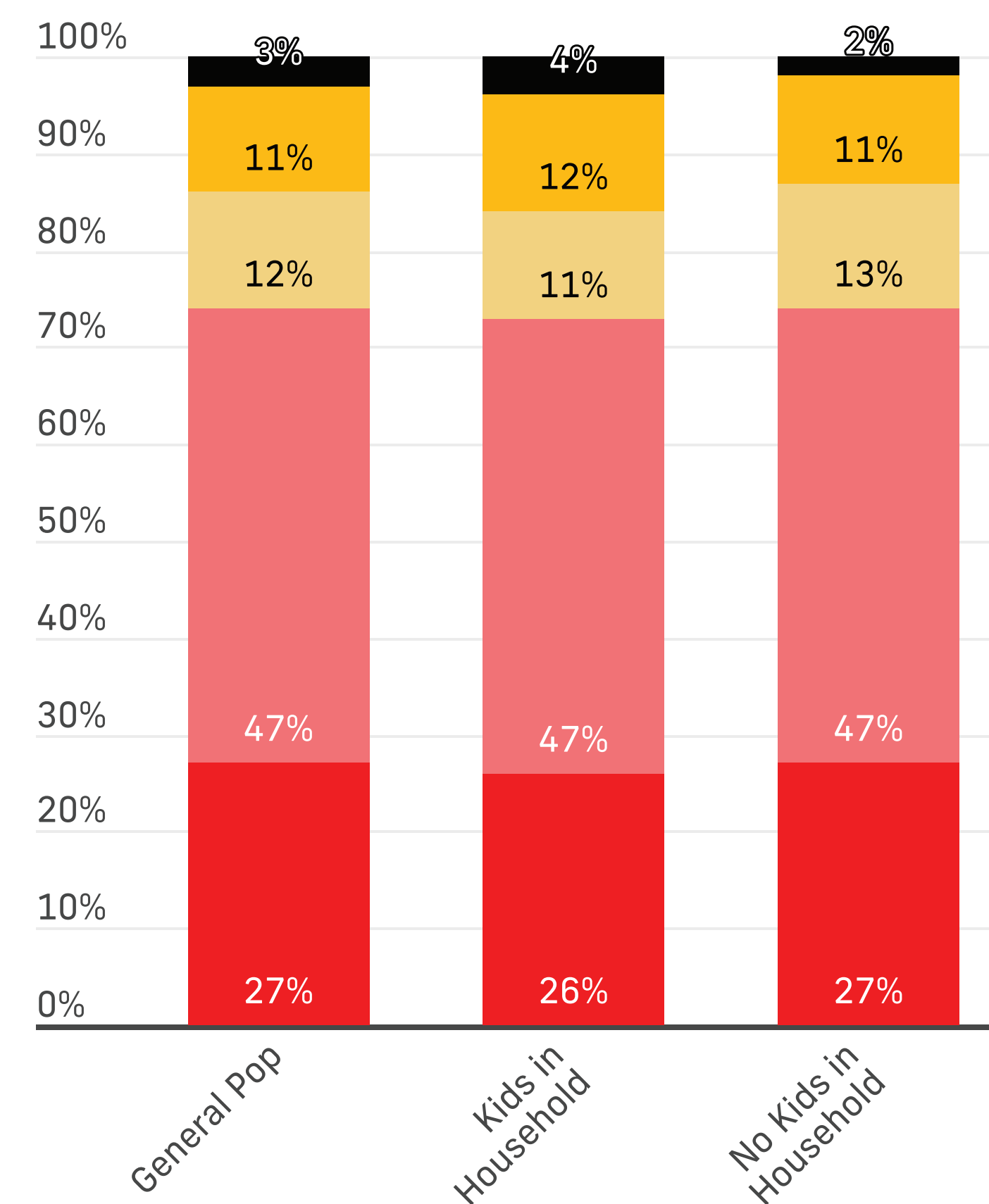

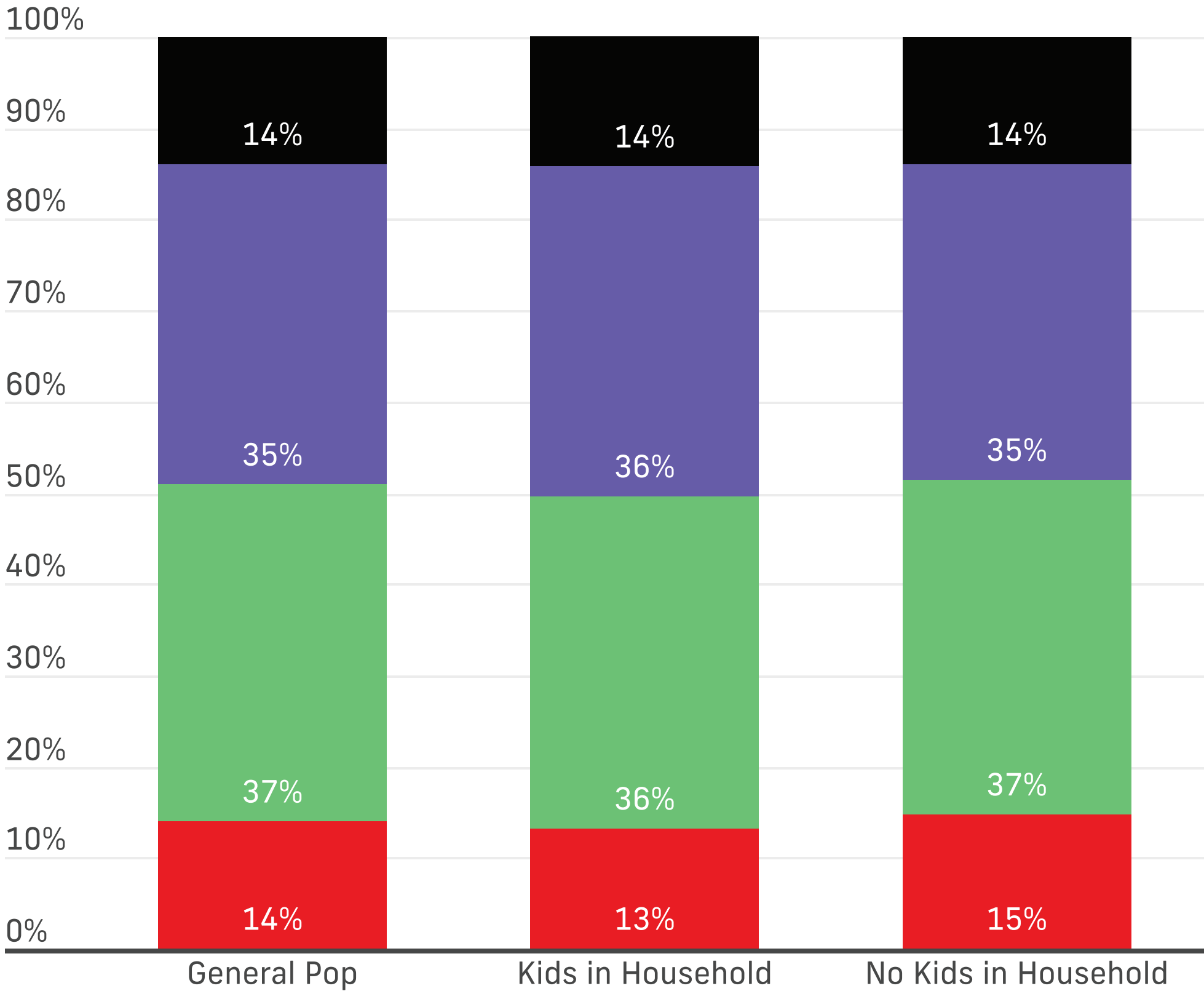

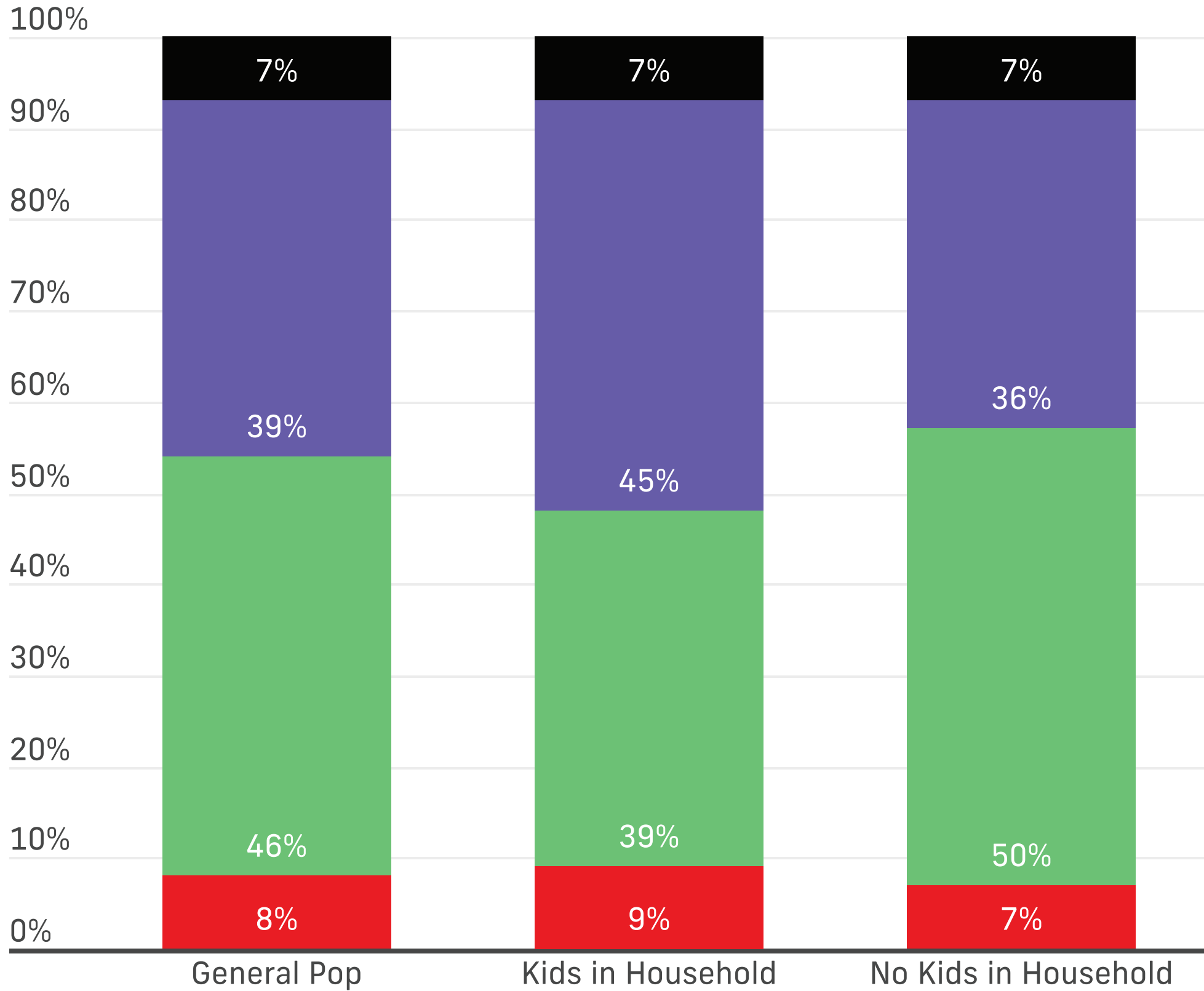

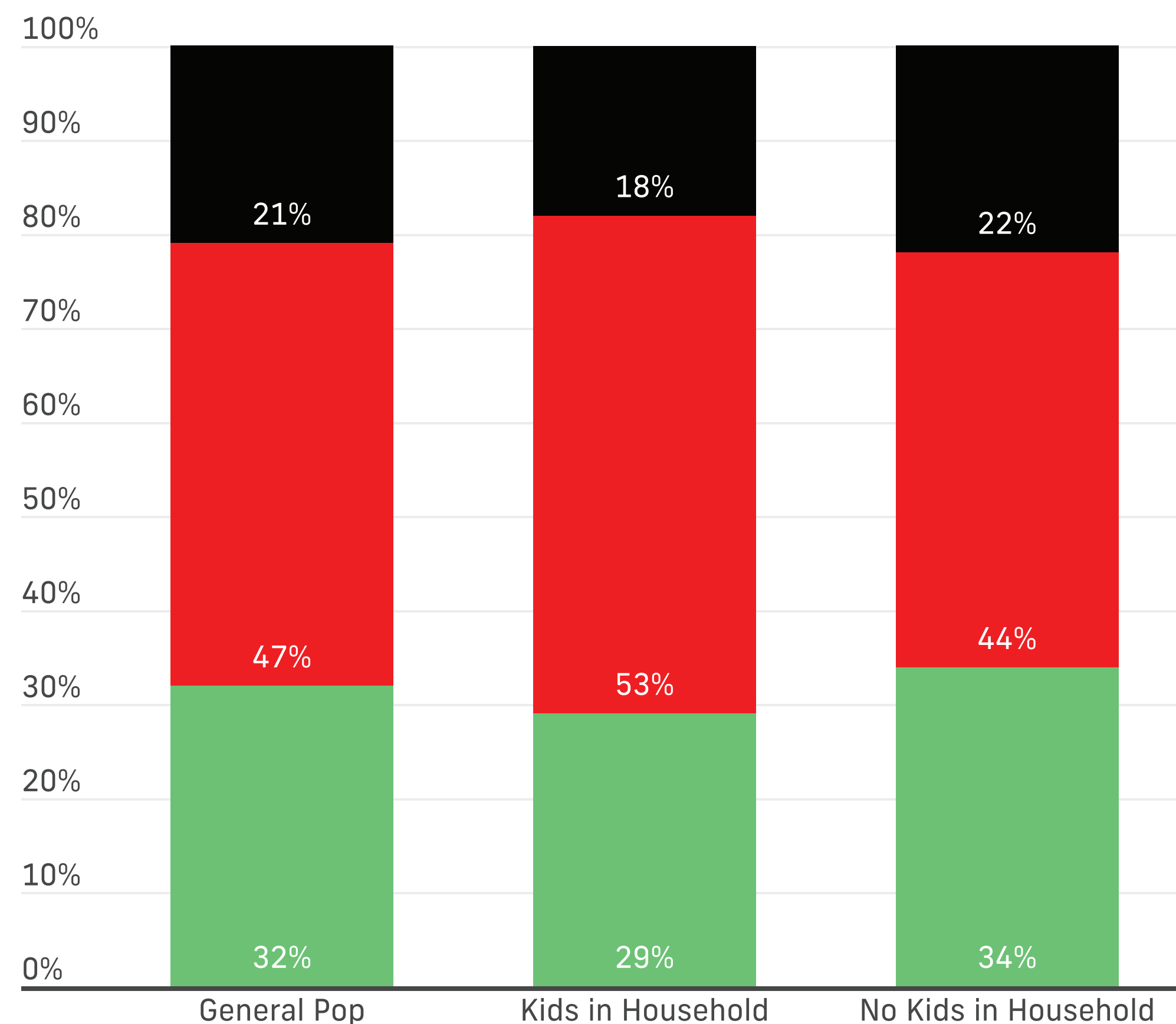

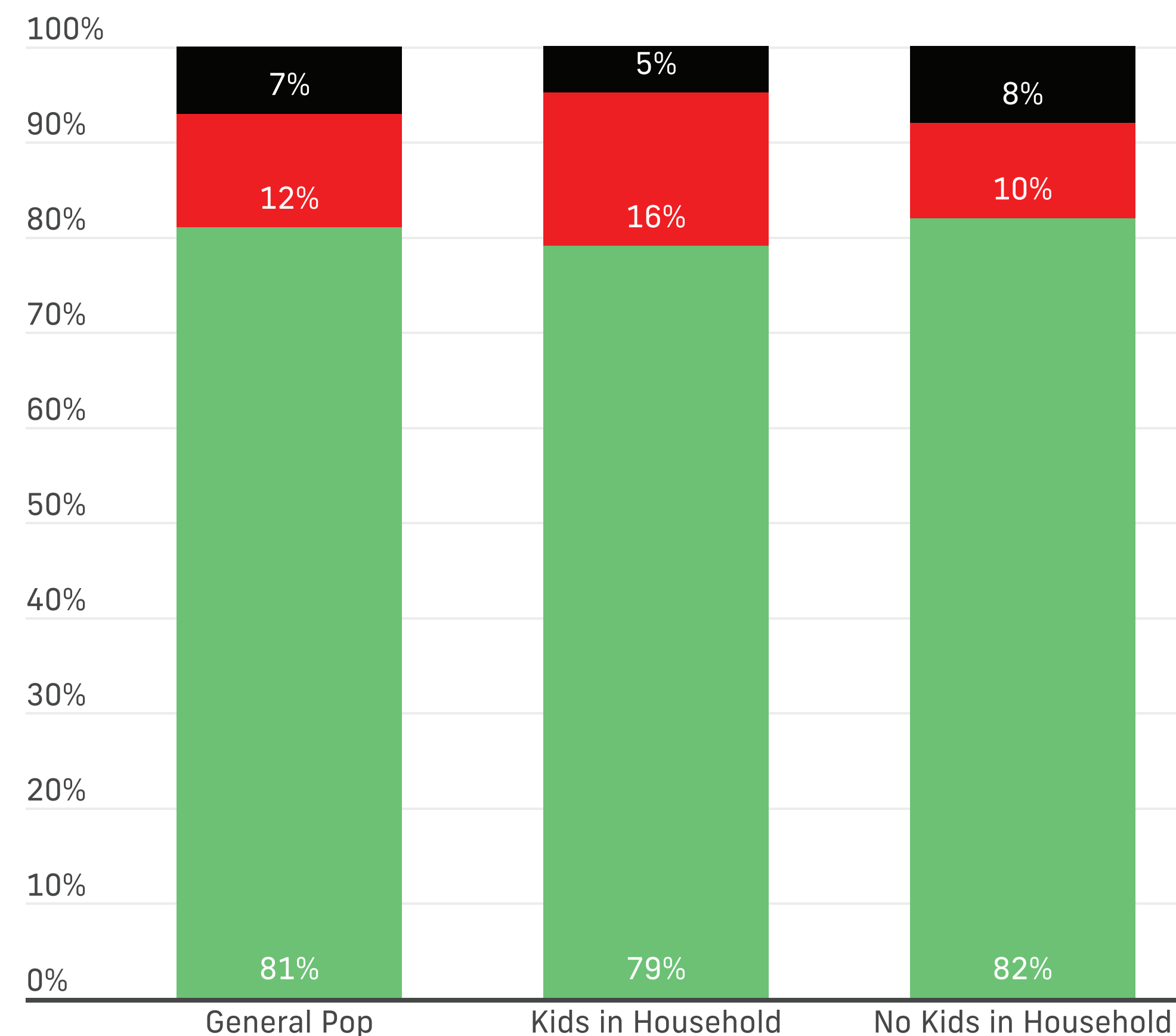

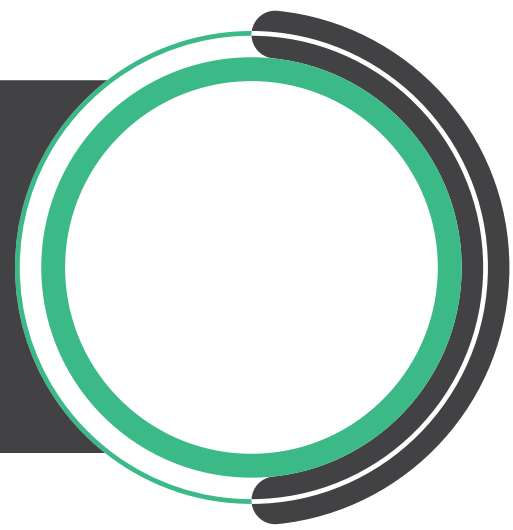

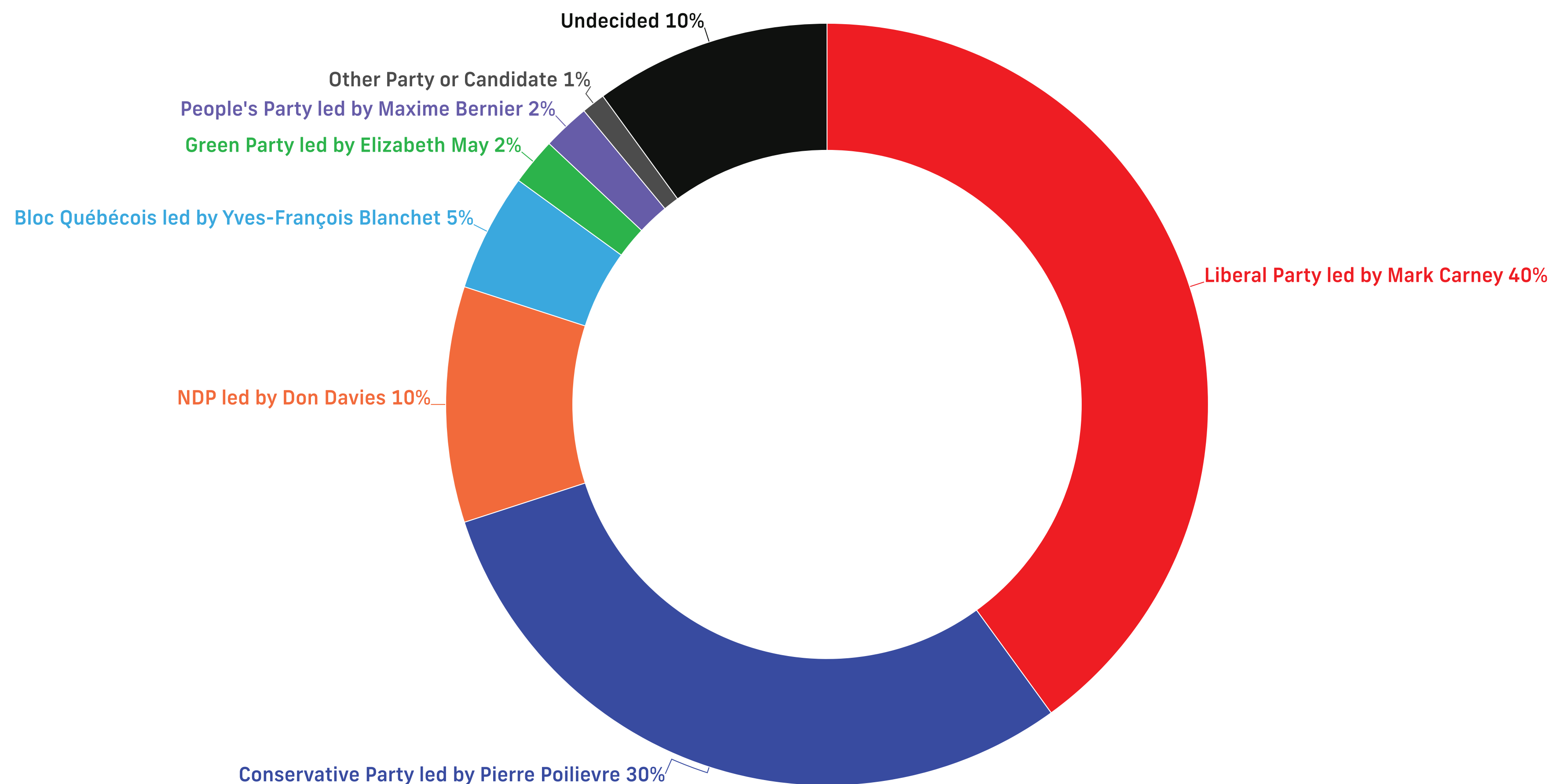

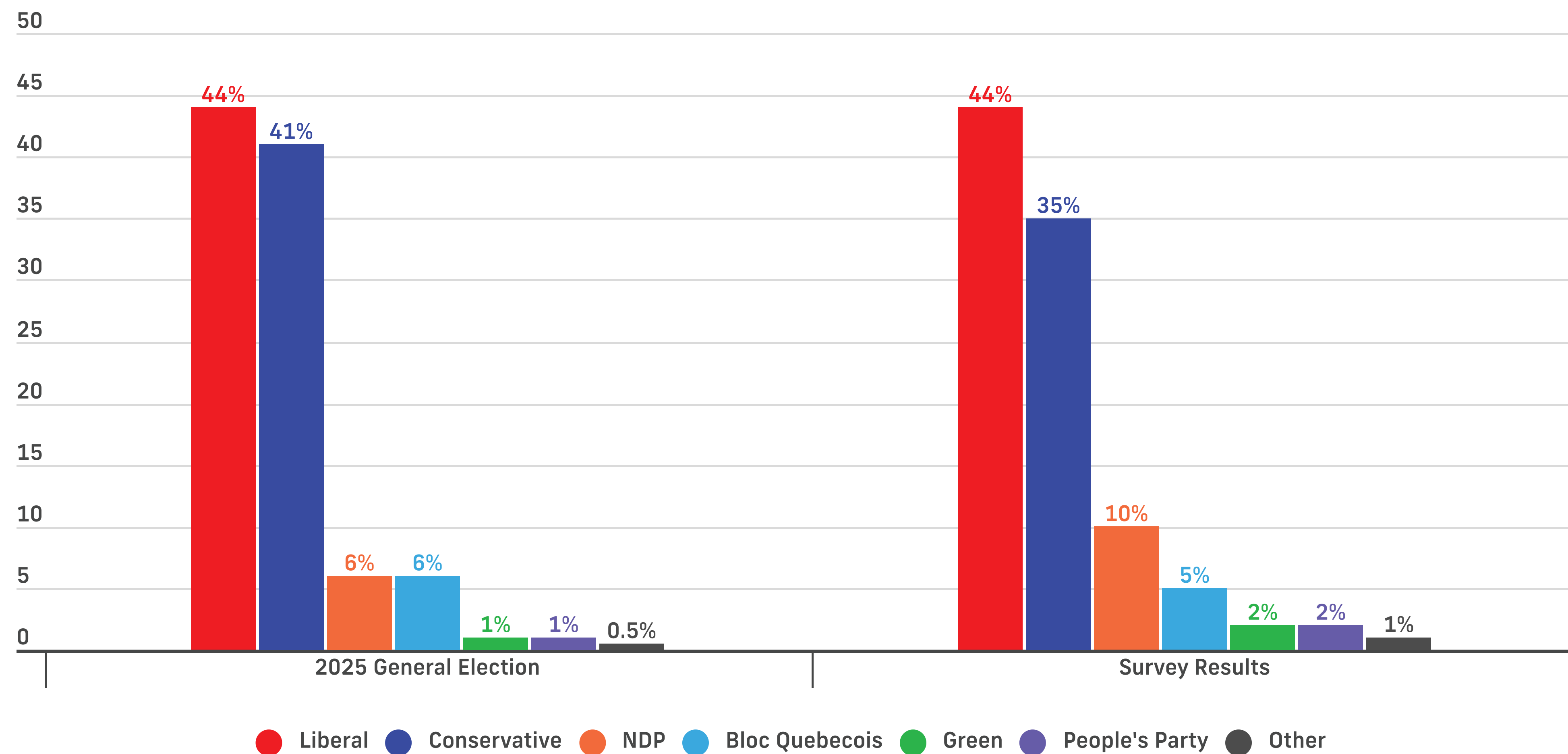
Q: If a Federal Election were held today, which party would you vote for?





Voting Intent - Federal - Decided & Leaning Only

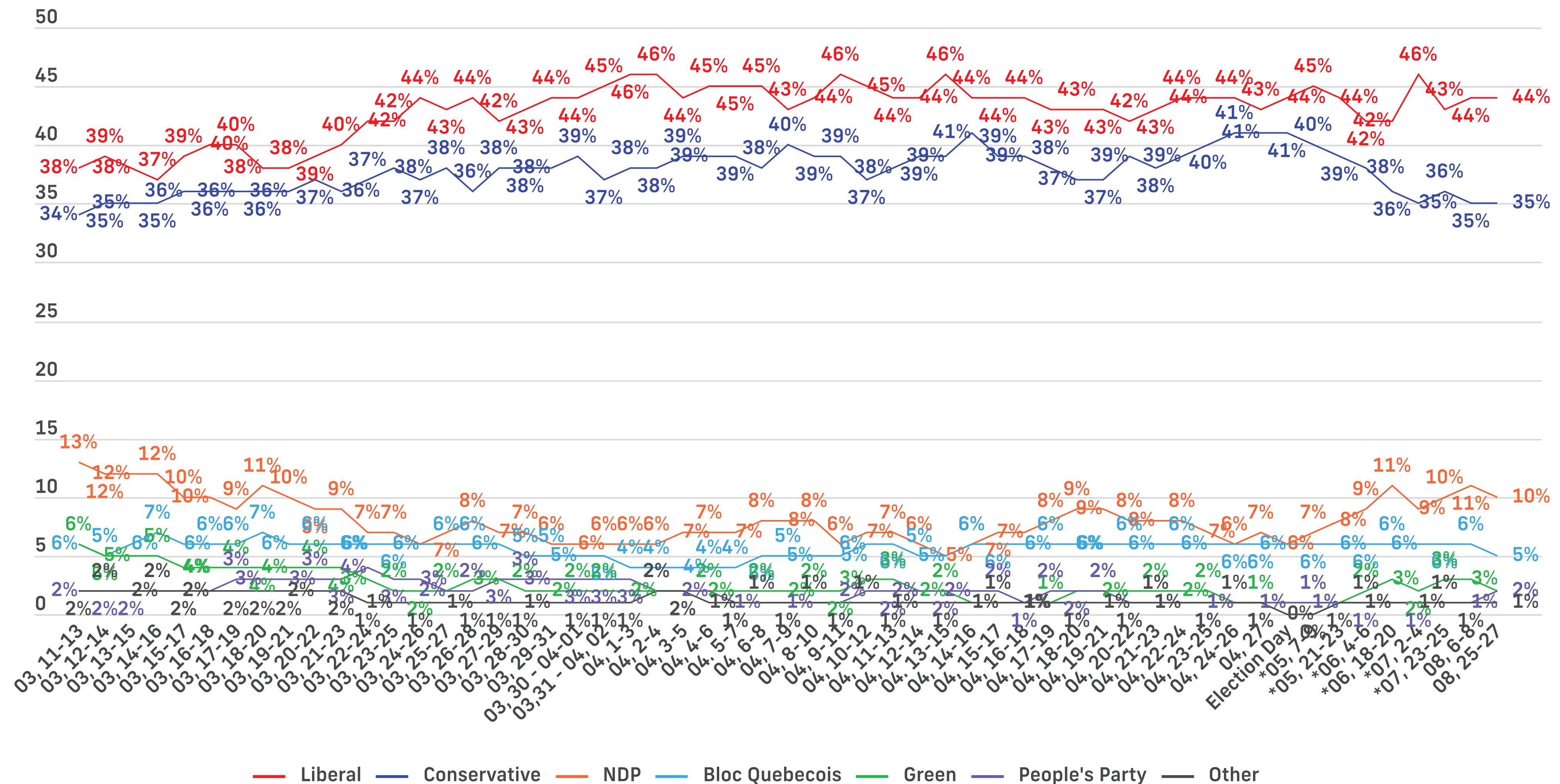
*Q: If a Federal Election were held today, which party would you vote for?

& (Undecided Only): And which party are you leaning towards?*

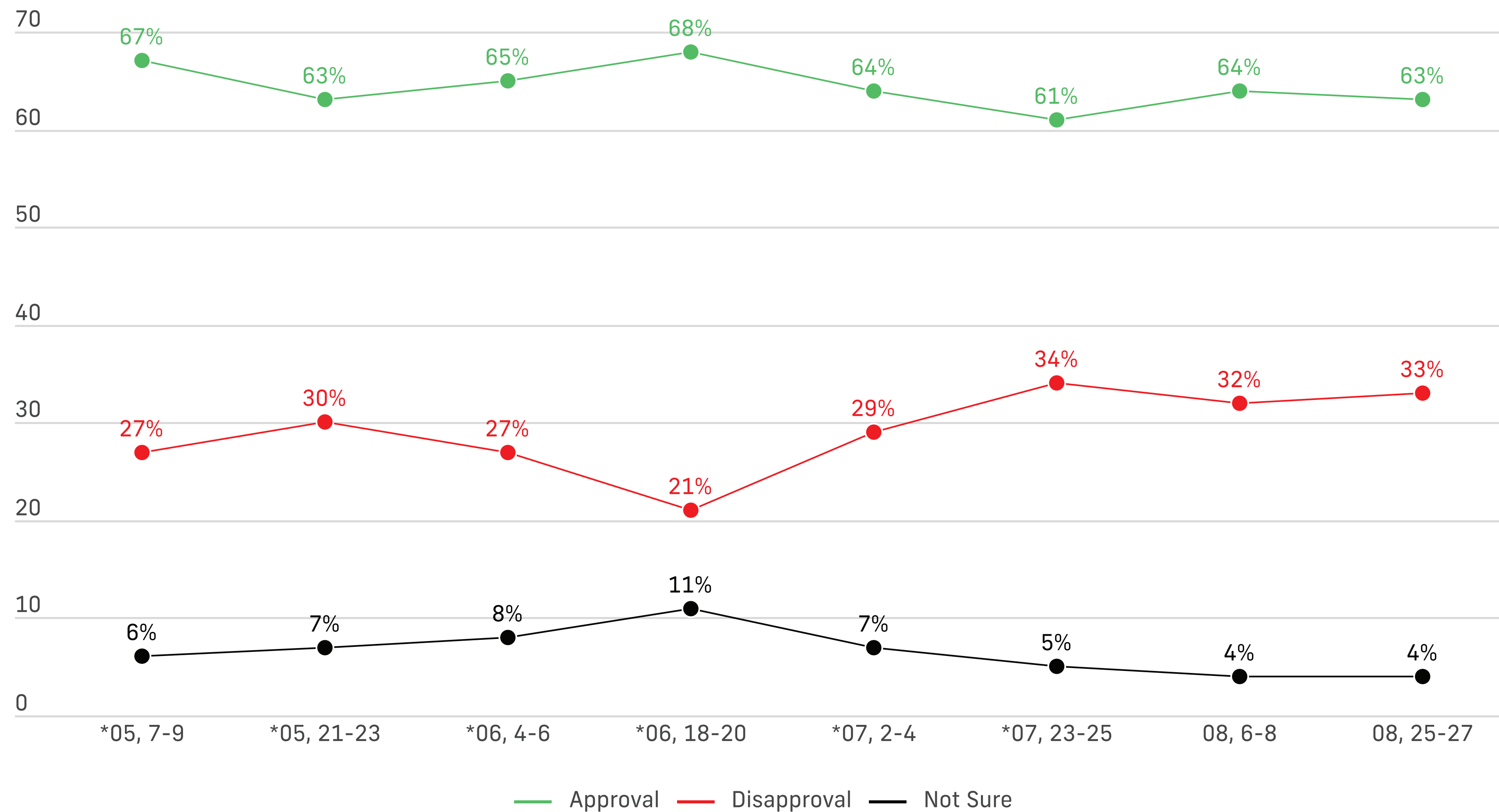

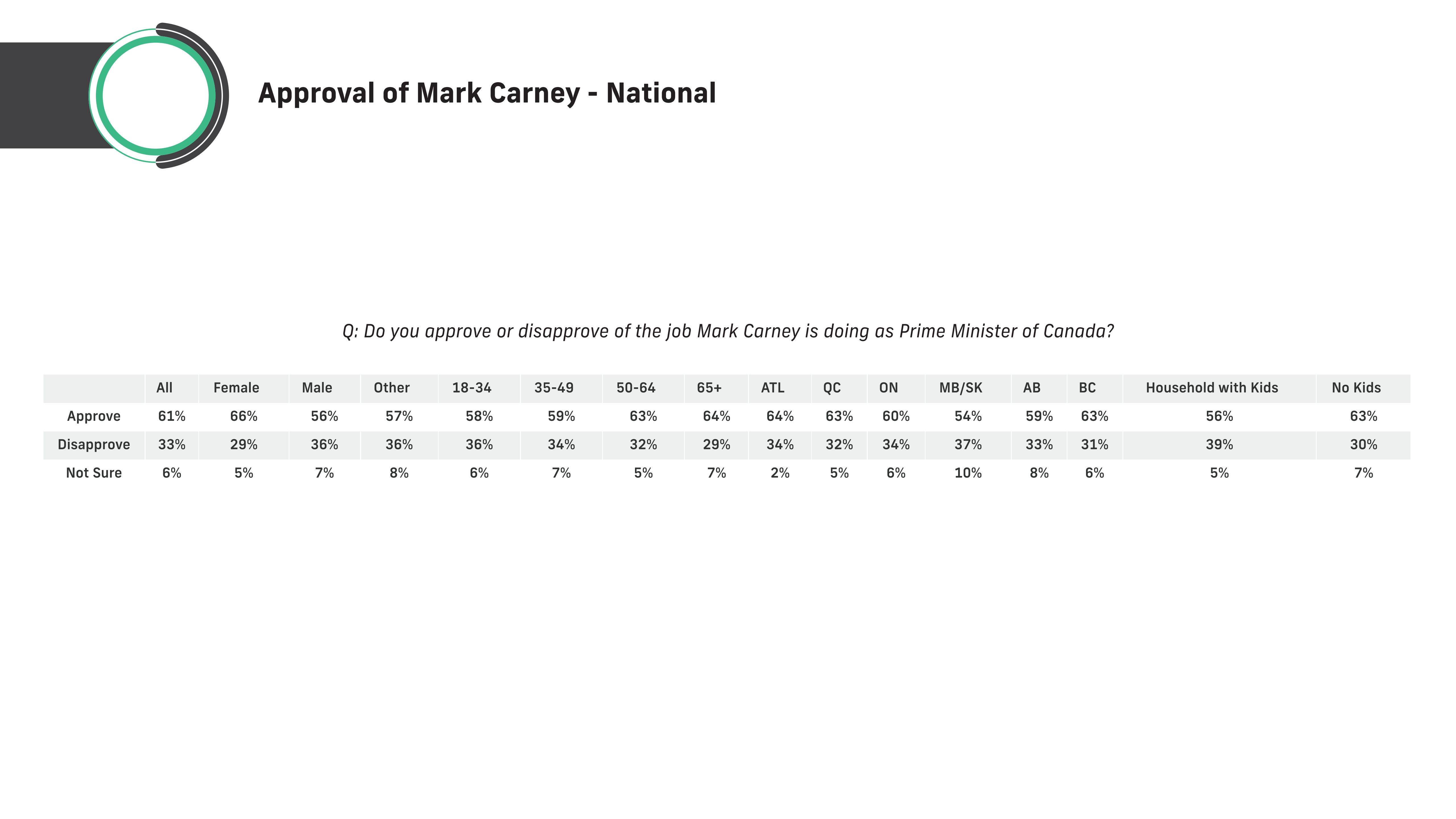

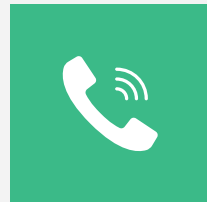
