


Liaison surveyed a random sample of 800 Ontario residents through Interactive Voice Recording (IVR) from October 14-15.

Responses were weighted by demographic and geographic characteristics according to 2021 Census targets.


The margin of error for survey results is ± 3.4 percentage points, 19 times out of 20 for the total. The margin of error is higher for sub-samples

Results may not add up to 100 due to rounding.

Q: If a Provincial Election were held today, which party would you vote for?








#### **Voting Intent - Ontario - Decided & Leaning Only**

Q: If a Provincial Election were held today, which party would you vote for? & (Undecided Only): And which candidate are you leaning towards?








Q: If a Provincial Election were held today, which party would you vote for? & (Undecided Only): And which candidate are you leaning towards?









#### **Ontario - Speed Cameras**

Q: From everything you have seen, read or heard, do you approve or disapprove of the decision to ban speed cameras?














