
Liaison fielded surveys in the ten largest cities in Ontario through Interactive Voice Recording (IVR) from October 22-23, 2025.

Responses were weighted using demographic and geographic information to targets based on the 2021 Census.

Margins of error are 19 times out of 20 for the total and higher for sub-samples.



MAYORAL APPROVAL RATINGS - OVERVIEW


*Do you approve or disapprove of the job *NAME* is doing as Mayor of *City*?
In order of net approval (approval minus disapproval)*








Q: *If a Federal Election were held today, which party would you vote for?*

CITY of TORONTO - MAYORAL APPROVAL RATING


Q: Do you approve or disapprove of the job Olivia Chow is doing as Mayor of Toronto?




Q: If an election were held today, for whom would you cast your vote for mayor?






CITY of TORONTO - DIRECTION OF THE CITY


Q: In your opinion is the City of Toronto moving in the right direction or the wrong direction?



CITY of TORONTO - TOP ISSUE


Q: In your opinion what is the most important issue facing the City of Toronto: affordable housing, crime, homelessness, inflation, traffic, transit or something else?








